Core Units

- HLTINF402B Maintain infection control standards in office practice settings
- SIBBHR5705A Apply intense pulsed light and laser safety protocols
- SIBBHR5706A Design intense pulsed light and laser hair reduction treatment programs
- SIBBHR5707A Provide intense pulsed light and laser hair reduction treatments
- SIBBRES702A Investigate developments in cosmetic treatments using light or laser systems

Course Duration

- 5 days face to face training – 10 am to 5 pm
- Practical hours completed in salon and home study – approximately 320 hours total (completed over 4 months = 20 hour per week)
- 1 day assessment at the end of the course

Course Duration

- 5 days face to face training – 10 am to 5 pm
- Practical hours in salon and home study – approximately 360 hours total (completed over 4 months = 22 hour per week)
- 1 day assessment at the end of the course

Please Note:

Licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification considerations for the use of Class 4 Laser for cosmetic treatments is currently subject to the following:

- **Queensland Radiation Safety Act 1999**, licensing of operator and premises
- **Tasmanian Radiation Protection Act 2005** – accreditation of equipment, premises and operator
- **Western Australian Radiation Safety Act 1975** - imposes conditions, limitations and restrictions on the use of Class 4 lasers.
- **Other states and territories**, no licensing, regulatory or certification requirements apply at the time of endorsement
